1. Introduction of Late Items:

2. Approval of Agenda:

3. Gibbs Custom Sawing Presentation:

GM visited previously. Report presented showed the recovery percentage per 1000 board foot. Andy has been critiquing this idea for 10 years, looking for support to build it. Could produce 15,000 board feet/day (1.5 loads), anything under 10" to 4". Market is building again, of course there are a few unknowns. The plan is to get recovery up. Annual Operating days, hoping for all year, with 5 people running. Pay back by increasing /m3, ie 35 loads – 15 (loan payment) + 35 (rate now) = 50, til paid off, then stay at 50 (probably 2 years to pay). Understood the MCFC can't feed entirely, there is also DCF and VCF. Pay back timeline would be as follows – received wood, 2 weeks to process, Gibbs pd, then MCFC paid = 45 days. Andy to build plan and paper and provide to MCFC.
