

MCFC - General Update

November 7, 2025

Harvesting:

RV Pepper has completed harvesting on the eastern polygon on block CL04 in the Legrand area just off Lamco Road. The remaining +/-12ha will be harvested under winter conditions. This block is a 37ha leading Hemlock with minor of cedar and SPF.

Warren McLennan has stopped harvesting on block MC07 up the Spinner Road due to road conditions. The block is roughly half complete. Harvesting is planned to resume next summer 2026.

Winter season 2025/26 log sales: Pulp sold to Canfor, SPF sawlog to Carrier until December 31, 2025. Cedar sold to Cedar3, BKB, local sawmills and Gilbert Smith.

SPF sawlog will be reassessed late December for January 1 to March 31, 2026.

The winter 2025/26 harvest plan is set until January 1 then will reassess the markets.

Roads:

Schapansky built a short spur into the western polygon on CL04. This was tendered out to two contractors.

Looking to build the road into MV01. 700m of upgrade and 900m of new construction.

Bridges:

DWB completed all bridge inspections and two bridge replacement site surveys. The last bridge survey for Fleet creek crossing is in. They are proposing a 27m bridge at 15km and a 18m bridge at 19km.

Planning/Other:

ORM is laying out new roads and blocks up Mountainview and Clyde Creek.

Clausen is lined up to help with burning and road and block layout.

MCF reccing areas for fall/winter layout.

Working on site plans for winter harvest.

Reference numbers are in place with the start of burning waiting for winter conditions. Following new burning policy.

Silviculture:

3 of 4 request keys are approved for spring trees 2027. Waiting on a pine seedlot to become available to complete last one. Ordering a total of 250,000 trees made up of Spruce, Cedar, Pine and Douglas Fir.

Recreation:

Quiet for winter. Our partners at Rec Sites have approved us for a \$5000 payment towards our 2025 expenses.
