

## **MCFC - General Update**

February 3, 2026

### **Harvesting:**

Warm weather has slowed harvest and hauling especially on new road construction into SS05 and CL11.

RV Pepper has completed harvesting on CL02, roughly 16ha. Half of the block was harvested during the winter of 2025. Mixed block of hemlock, cedar, spruce and balsam. Pepper is now logging right of way into block CL08. CL08 is a 37ha HwCwSxBI mixed block.

Warren McLennan is harvesting block CL10 and CL11 located in the Clyde Creek area, 25ha. These blocks are mainly HwCw with a minor of spruce and balsam.

Schapansky Logging is harvesting block SS05 in the Snowshoe area, 90% complete. This block is 42ha of spruce and balsam. Schapansky will move to block CC05 next. CC05 is a HwCwSx block.

Winter season 2025/26 log sales: Pulp sold to Canfor, SPF sawlog to Carrier. Cedar sold to Cedar3, BKB, local sawmills and Gilbert Smith.

### **Roads:**

Schapansky has built two spur roads into block SS05. The road construction side has now moved to gaining access to block CC05 which is in the Snowshoe/Catfish area. 2km of freezing in old road and minor upgrade and +/-2km of new construction in the block.

ORM has built spur roads into blocks CL10 and CL11.

ORM is building a 1km spur road into block CL08 located in the Clyde Creek area.

### **Bridges:**

ORM has installed a 6m bridge over a S4 stream in block SS05. This bridge is a temporary bridge and will be pulled as soon as hauling is complete.

ORM has installed a 9m bridge over a S4 creek for access into block CL08. Temporary bridge.

### **Planning/Other:**

ORM is laying out new roads and blocks up Mountainview, 400 road.

Clausen has started to lay out road and blocks up Snowshoe and Clyde Creek.

MCF has met with Simpcw FN and agreed to a trade for Big Tree Old Growth Deferrals. MCF gains harvest areas in CL08, CC05, MC06 and CL12. We will move the old growth deferral into an area in the Dominion Creek domestic watershed.

### **Silviculture:**

ORM has been contracted to complete SP amendments on about 20 blocks. When the amendments are complete they will submit into Phoenix and then RESULTS.

**Recreation:** Grading Bell weekly to the 4km parking lot.
